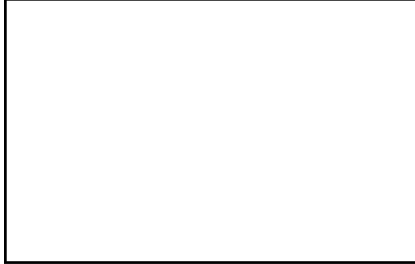

Latest on Golf Course Projects

The staff members have been very busy working on a multitude of projects this spring. Some of the projects include the following:

Tree Management and Drainage Projects:

- The tree and stump areas that were worked on this winter have been restored to grass.
- Tons of soil was used to fill the void where poplar trees and their massive root system existed.
- In an effort to speed up play, the ongoing project of clearing out wooded areas will continue near the numbers six and eight rough, and also to the right side of number fifteen fairway.
- Drainage work was completed on number thirteen near the restroom and also on number eight rough.

Landscaping:

- The clubhouse area has been enhanced by adding new shrubbery and annuals.
- Additional ornamental trees and shrubs were also added on the golf course near three tee and green and seven and sixteen tee.

Course Maintenance and Grooming

- We have installed over 50 tons of sand in several bunkers. *The average sand depth should be maintained at four to six inches* new rakes have been placed around many bunkers.
- From Memorial Day to Labor Day, we groom and detail the golf course as the staff is at peak capacity.
- We hand mow putting greens daily and roll the greens up to three times a week.
- In mid June topdressing was applied to reduce thatch build up and to increase greens speed. *We plan to topdress every three weeks during the summer season.*
- Putting greens were spiked/vent tine aerated in June to promote air and water flow.
- There was a noticeable amount of the disease Anthracnose on the putting greens, we made adjustments in the nutritional and fungicide applications to correct the problem.
